Under the authority of the federal Clean Water Act and Pennsylvania's Clean Streams Law, the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has approved your request for a minor amendment to your permit. The latest versions of the application and all supporting documents, including the Erosion and Sediment Control (E&S) Plan and Post-Construction Stormwater Management (PCSM) Plan, are incorporated into this approval, including the following plan drawings:

- The E&S Plan drawings for **Williamsport Ballpark, Inc.**, dated **August 4, 2021**, and most recently revised **May 1, 2024**.
- The PCSM Plan drawings for **Williamsport Ballpark, Inc.**, dated **August 4, 2021**, and most recently revised **May 1, 2024**.

The terms and conditions of your permit, including the expiration date of **August 16, 2026**, have not otherwise changed. In addition, if stormwater discharges associated with construction activities are expected to continue beyond the expiration date of your coverage, you must apply to renew your coverage at least 180 days prior to the expiration date, unless otherwise approved by the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) or the District.
